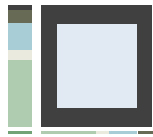

Forming disciples of Jesus Christ

Children develop in similar ways but their development may vary according to their individual stages of cognitive, social-emotional, physical and spiritual development, learning styles, and ability levels. Make sure to be aware that children have different abilities at different ages and that some children may live with a disability or delay in some developmental areas. The following chart is a guide. Because children come to us with varying abilities and experiences, it is important to see this chart as flowing rather than absolute. Children need to experience the same Bible stories and Christian concepts at several different stages of their faith journey, because their ability to understand the story/concepts continues to evolve as they grow.
