

## **The 'Source: Leadership One day training event**

### **Supply List**

- Nametags
- Markers
- Masking tape, blue painters' tape or blue tacky stuff to stick things to walls
- List of registrants
- Blank forms for walk-ins to fill out (if you are taking walk-ins)
- Worship center/communion table/altar supplies (cross, candles, stones, fabric or cloths)
- Microphones/sound system
- Power point projector
- Laptop with Power point capabilities
- Extension cords – in case it's a long way from the laptop and projector to the wall!
- Appropriate cords to hook up computer and projector
- Projection screen or blank wall
- Fabric and cloth for: worship center/altar; under tea lights at prayer worship station
- Matches or lighter
- Candles
  - 1-3 pillars for worship center
  - 1 pillar for candle lighting station
  - Bag of tea light candles for candle lighting station
- Snacks (juice, water, coffee all day) possible a.m. snacks: bagels or muffins, granola bars, breakfast bars, crackers, cheese, boiled eggs
  - Possible afternoon snacks: cookies, nuts, raisins, or chocolate
- Pipe cleaners
- Cans of Playdoh (can be small cans), about 1 can per person
- 4"x6" painting canvases mounted on heavy cardboard
- Acrylic paints
- Paint brushes
- Drop cloths (2)
- Small bowls for water in which to rinse brushes
- Pens for participants (perhaps the annual conference or a specialized ministry in your conference will donate them)
- Folders for participants to keep handouts (perhaps the annual conference or a specialized ministry in your conference will donate them)
- Paper people (can be purchased at school supply stores)
- Note cards (closing worship)
- Chalice and paten (closing worship)
- Communion bread and juice (closing worship)
- Copyright permission for songs
- Copyright permission for movie clips
- Liquid glue that can be squeezed out in a thin stream (for finger labyrinth)
- Colored sand, 2 or 3 colors (finger labyrinth)
- Copies of finger labyrinth on heavy card stock
- Leadership quotes – put them up on the wall around the room

# Prayer Station Set Up

### **Candle Lighting**

Can be on the floor or a table (CHECK BUILDING FIRE CODE). (Can use pie plates filled with sand to set candles in to help prevent unwanted fire) Put down decorative cloths. Have a pillar candle in the center with tea lights spread out on the table. The tea lights can be in a random pattern or in the shape of a cross or circle. Have the pillar candle lit at the beginning of worship. The pillar candle will be the candle from which people light the tea lights.

### **Painting**

Have one or two oblong tables covered with drop cloths. Also put drop cloths down under the tables and chairs. Put out the canvases, paint, brushes and bowls of water. Have some paper towels on the table also so that people can wipe off fingers or extra water from brushes. Having towels close by also readily facilitates cleaning up spills.

### **Finger Labyrinth**

On one or two oblong tables, have smalls bowls of 2-3 different colors of art sand, liquid glue, finger labyrinth explanation cards and the printouts of the labyrinth. Labyrinth can be printed out from:
